Membership: We have now 217 effective members (+22% since last newsletter) in 152 centres from 45 countries.

JSLE and JDM disease activity and damage core sets of outcome measures and definition of improvement (EU grant QLG1-CT-2000-00514).

The prospective validation of the JSLE-JDM core sets is **COME TO THE END** of the enrollment phase. We have collected 518 JSLE and 284 JDM patients from 41 countries (see table next page) with an increase of more than 40% since last time.

IMPORTANT:

enrollment is FINISHED and we will continue <u>ONLY</u> to collect prospective data at visit 2 (4-8 months after visit 1) DO NOT SEND ANY NEW PATIENT <u>BUT REMEMBER TO SEND VISIT 2</u> <u>WITH THE EFFICACY ASSESSMENT</u>

(patients improved, stable, or worsened according to MD' and the parents' opinion)By the end of September all centres will receive payment from PRINTO:

• About **350 Euro** for the following EU countries: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Israel, I- taly, Latvia, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Northern Ireland, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, United Kingdom.

 For all the other countries, the EU has granted the authorisation to spend 20% of the funding. Therefore non EU centres will be reimbursed about 120 Euro/patients).
